REPORT OF THE PROGRAM

Program highlights:

Dr. K. Loganathan has completed PGCTE (Post Graduate Certificate in Teaching of English) in EFL University, Hyderabad currently working as assistant professor of English in Chettinad Academy of Research and Education. He has received doctorate from SRM University gave a lecture on the importance of the English language as a common language in clinical practice even if we move to different states for practice. The lecture was interactive with fun activities and a learning experience. The first session of the program started with classes that covered the basics in English grammar which helped the students to understand the errors in their communication, also increased their interest towards the language. The next session the expectancy of the language was increased by specifically explaining about their common mistakes in their sentences that dentists use regularly during a conversation with their patients. Later on, the same day the students were ask to talk among themselves as a doctor: patient conversation and made the day more interesting. On the last session the students were given exercises based on the previous lessons. Mainly crossword puzzles were given individually for all students and quiz was also conducted as group activity. CDE Program on Ethics in Public Health Bioinformatics – 2023-24

Detailed Program Report

A virtual CDE program for professional development on Ethics in Public Health Bioinformatics was conducted by the Department of Public Health Dentistry, on 10th June 2024, from 1.15 pm to 3.15 pm, targeting dental faculty and students and aimed at enhancing their understanding of the growing relevance of ethics in bioinformatics in the field of dental public health. The speaker was Dr.G.Aparna, MDS, Assistant Professor, Department of Periodontology, Sri Ramachandra Dental College and Hospital, Chennai. The seminar covered key topics that outlined the importance, scope, and applications of bioinformatics in healthcare, with a focus on dental public health under the following headings

Introduction to Bioinformatics

Ethics plays a crucial role in public health bioinformatics by ensuring that data is used responsibly and with respect for individual privacy and confidentiality. It safeguards sensitive health information, promoting transparency and informed consent in data collection and sharing processes. Ethical principles help ensure that data use benefits the public while minimizing harm, ensuring equitable access and treatment for all populations. Additionally, ethics guide decision-making to avoid biases and protect vulnerable groups, ensuring that public health interventions are both effective and just.

Ethics in bioinformatics is essential for the responsible handling of biological and health data. It focuses on safeguarding privacy, ensuring data accuracy, and preventing misuse, especially with sensitive genetic or health-related information. Ethical guidelines promote transparency, requiring informed consent and equitable access to bioinformatics tools and research outcomes. By adhering to ethical principles, bioinformatics can advance science while protecting individual rights and fostering trust in the research and healthcare communities.

Branches of Bioinformatics

The seminar then explored the various branches of bioinformatics, which include:

- 1. **Genomics**: Focuses on analyzing whole-genome sequences, identifying genetic variations, and understanding the functional elements of DNA.
- 2. **Proteomics**: Deals with the study of protein structures, functions, and interactions, which are critical for understanding various biological processes and disease mechanisms.
- 3. **Transcriptomics**: Examines RNA transcripts and how gene expression changes under different conditions.
- 4. **Metabolomics**: Involves the study of metabolites and metabolic networks to understand biochemical processes within cells.
- 5. **Systems Biology**: An integrative approach that examines the complex interactions within biological systems, helping to understand how systems operate as a whole.



These branches provide a holistic view of biological processes, making bioinformatics a critical tool in both basic and applied biomedical research.

Fields in Bioinformatics

The seminar elaborated on the various fields within bioinformatics, which include:

- **Computational Biology**: Develops algorithms and models to understand biological systems and relationships.
- **Biomedical Informatics**: Focuses on the application of bioinformatics in healthcare, particularly for improving medical practice and research.
- **Pharmacogenomics**: Studies how genetic variations affect individual responses to drugs, enabling the development of personalized medicine.
- **Environmental Informatics**: Investigates the impact of environmental factors on health and disease.
- **Public Health Informatics**: Applies bioinformatics to understand population health trends and develop strategies for disease prevention and control.

Each of these fields contributes to improving healthcare delivery and public health outcomes by leveraging data analysis and computational tools.

Tools in Bioinformatics

The seminar provided an overview of popular bioinformatics tools and software used for data analysis, such as:

- **BLAST** (**Basic Local Alignment Search Tool**): Used for comparing an input DNA sequence to other sequences in a database to identify similarities.
- Clustal Omega: A tool for multiple sequence alignment.
- **R and Bioconductor**: A programming language and environment for statistical computing, widely used for bioinformatics analysis.
- **Cytoscape**: A software platform for visualizing molecular interaction networks and biological pathways.
- **Gene Ontology**: A tool that helps in the classification of gene functions across species.

These tools help researchers analyze biological data, visualize complex networks, and draw meaningful conclusions that are vital for advancing medical and dental research.

Bioinformatics in Dental Public Health

The seminar discussed the increasing relevance of bioinformatics in dental public health. The integration of bioinformatics enables dental researchers to understand genetic predispositions to oral diseases, such as periodontitis, dental caries, and oral cancer. By analyzing large datasets, bioinformatics can identify biomarkers for early diagnosis, track disease outbreaks, and improve the understanding of microbial ecosystems in the oral cavity.

The application of bioinformatics in dental research helps in developing preventive measures, improving treatment strategies, and enhancing patient care in a cost-effective and timely manner.



Count of How good were you...




Count of Which aspect do you...


