

Abstract

Background:
This randomized, double-blind, parallel arm study was carried out to evaluate and compare the effectiveness between nano-hydroxyapatite (NHAP) and a benchmark dentifrice in reducing dentin hypersensitivity.

Materials and Methods:
About 36 patients were selected, randomly divided into two groups and was evaluated clinically using three different stimuli, i.e., tactile, air blast, and cold water test. The patient's responses to various stimuli were recorded using a visual analog scale at baseline and after 4 weeks.

Results:
Statistical analysis was done using unpaired and paired t-tests. It was seen that patients treated in both groups showed significant reductions scores across all sensitivity measures at the end of 4 weeks.

Conclusion:
The HAP containing toothpaste was effective in reducing dentin hypersensitivity with one existing benchmark toothpaste tested and

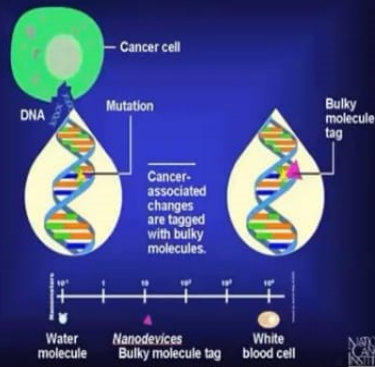

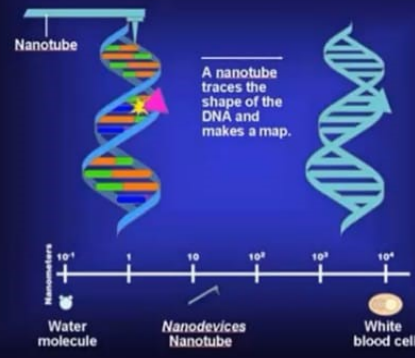

Nanotubes – Marking Mutations



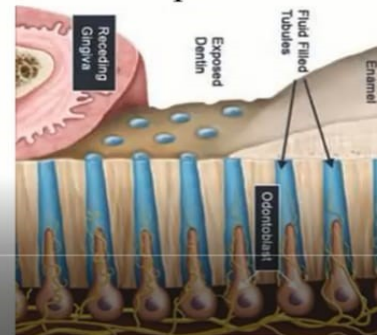
Nanotubes – Mapping Mutations

1. Diminish the frequency and severity of the acid challenge

- Decrease amount and frequency of acidic foods or drinks
- Acidic drinks should be drunk quickly rather than sipped. The use of a straw would reduce the erosive potential of soft drinks
- If undiagnosed or poorly controlled gastroesophageal reflux is suspected, refer to a physician
- In the case of bulimia, a physician or psychologist referral is appropriate
- A patient with alcoholism should be assisted in seeking treatment in rehabilitation programs

2. Enhance the defense mechanisms of the body (increase salivary flow and pellicle formation)

- Saliva provides buffering capacity that resists acid attacks. This buffering capacity increases with salivary flow rate
- Saliva is also supersaturated with calcium and phosphorus, which inhibits demineralization of tooth structure
- Stimulation of salivary flow by use of a sugarless lozenge, candy or gum is recommended

3. Enhance acid resistance, remineralization and rehardening of the tooth surfaces

- Have the patient use daily topical fluoride at home
- Apply fluoride in the office 2-4 times a year. A fluoride varnish is recommended

In order to distinguish MRONJ from other delayed healing conditions and address evolving clinical observations and concerns about under-reporting of disease, the working definition of MRONJ has been modified from the 2009 AAOMS Position Paper:¹

Patients may be considered to have MRONJ if all of the following characteristics are present:

1. Current or previous treatment with antiresorptive or antiangiogenic agents;
2. Exposed bone or bone that can be probed through an intraoral or extraoral fistula(e) in the maxillofacial region that has persisted for more than eight weeks; and
3. No history of radiation therapy to the jaws or

- The initial design cost is very high
- The design of the nanorobot is a very complicated
- Electrical nanorobots are susceptible to electrical interference from external sources such as RF or electric fields, electromagnetic pulse and stray fields from other *in vivo* electrical devices
- Hard to interface, customize and design, complex
- Nanorobots can cause a brutal risk in the field of terrorism. The terrorism and anti-groups can make use of nanorobots as a new form of torturing the communities as nanotechnology also has the capability of destructing the human body at the molecular level

Effective ways to brush the teeth of a child in a wheelchair

- Stand behind the wheelchair.
- Use the arm to brace the child's head against the wheelchair or against your body.
- Consider using a pillow so that the child is comfortable.
- Drape a towel around chest or lap to help with any mess. A clean wet washcloth could be helpful in removing excess toothpaste when a child is unable to rinse. If needed, follow with a squirt bottle or syringe of water to rinse the mouth. Catch excess in the towel or in a basin.

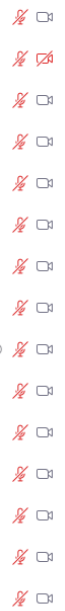
