



Adrenal crisis prophylaxis

- Patients on **long-term systemic steroid** have long been advised to take supplemental glucocorticoids or "**steroid cover**" when undergoing certain types of stressful treatment, including dental procedures.
- The basis for this practice is that exogenous steroids suppress the adrenal function to an extent that insufficient levels of cortisol can be produced in response to stress, posing a risk of acute adrenal crisis with **hypotension and collapse**.
- In the past, **The Rule of Twos** states that adrenal suppression may occur if a patient is taking **20 mg of hydrocortisone** or its equivalent daily, for **2 weeks** within **2 years** of dental treatment .(last 6 months – 1year)

DENTAL MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES FOR PATIENTS WITH ADRENAL INSUFFICIENCY.

- Define the risk of adrenal insufficiency through medical history and clinical examination. An increased risk of adrenal insufficiency exists when there is a history of tuberculosis or human immunodeficiency virus infection, since opportunistic infectious agents can attack the adrenal glands.^{20,21}
- Ensure that patients with adrenal insufficiency take their usual glucocorticoid dose before a stressful surgical procedure.
- Schedule surgery in the morning, when cortisol levels usually are highest.
- Provide proper stress reduction, since anxiety can increase cortisol demand.
- Minor surgeries require minimal steroid coverage. The patient's usual daily dose typically is sufficient.
- Major surgeries and those lasting more than one hour or involving general anesthesia should be performed in a hospital with steroid supplementation.
- Use of nitrous oxide-oxygen or intravenous or oral benzodiazepine sedation²² is helpful, since plasma cortisol levels are not reduced by these agents.²³
- Avoid general anesthesia for outpatient procedures, since it increases glucocorticoid demand.^{21,22} Avoid the use of barbiturates, since these drugs increase the metabolism of cortisol and reduce blood levels of cortisol.²³

Steroids in Endodontics

- The first **intracanal medication** using corticosteroids was reported by **Wofford** in 1954. In that study, he showed that hydrocortisone was effective in reducing severe **secondary inflammatory reactions** in the apical periodontal tissue following endodontic treatment.
- Thong et al.** reported that the use of **corticosteroid-antibiotic and calcium hydroxide** significantly reduced periapical ligament inflammation and inflammatory root resorption.
- Kaufman et al.** evaluated the effect of intraperiapical injection of corticosteroids on post-treatment pain. They found that intraperiapical injection of methylprednisolone significantly decreased post-treatment pain and later their histological study found that local infiltration of dexamethasone significantly **reduced inflammation** of the periapical tissue.






- **Steroid-induced myopathy** - reversible painless myopathy, a direct result of muscle breakdown - occur in both the upper and lower extremities, usually with high-dose long-term use of glucocorticoids.
- Muscle enzymes (CK and Aldolase) are typically normal, and findings on electromyography are non-specific.
- Withdrawal of glucocorticoids and exercises usually results in resolution of the myopathy.
- **"Critical illness myopathy"** may also develop in patients admitted in the ICU requiring large doses of IV glucocorticoids and neuromuscular blocking agents.
- It characteristically presents with a severe, diffuse, proximal and distal limb weakness that develops over several days.
- Although it is usually reversible, critical illness myopathy can lead to prolonged ICU admissions, increased length of hospital stays, severe necrotizing myopathy and increased mortality.

*Dr. Shivam Kapoor, the Technical Advisor in The Union spoke about the job opportunities available after BDS/MDS.


*Abroad job opportunities and educational facilities were also highlighted.


