

# WHAT IS PULPOTOMY?

"Complete removal of the coronal portion of the dental pulp, followed by placement of a suitable dressing or medicament that will promote healing and preserve the vitality of the tooth" (Finn, 1985).


"Pulpotomy is defined as the amputation of vital pulp from the coronal pulp chamber followed by placement of a medicament over the radicular pulp stumps to stimulate repair, fixation or mummification of the remaining vital radicular pulp". (Braham and Morris)

Access cavity

Start from exposure then go sideways - Do not touch floor




## Indications of SSC

- Extensive caries
- Pulpotomy / Pulpectomy
- · Developmental defects
- Severe bruxism
- Abutment for space maintainers. Fixed habit breaking appliances
- · Restoration of young permanent molar (after root canal treatment)
- · Anterior single tooth cross-bite correction




## Pretrimmed crowns (Unitek, 3M)

- Straight sides
- Shorter
- Festooned
- Minimal trimming
- Requires contouring
























Figure 10-20 Preventive resin/GIC restoration; R = restorative material (resin or GIC), S = sealant.
