CHEMOTHERAPY:


- German chemist Paul Ehrlich- Coined the term "chemotherapy"
- Originally chemotherapy referred to treatment of disease with drugs or chemical.
- In mid 1950's the term was only being used primarily in reference to drugs which were used to treat cancer.
- The first attempt to utilize chemotherapy in oncology was in 1942 using mustard nitrogen against malignant lymphoma.
- Since then many efforts have taken place toward the improvement of chemotherapy agents, the analysis of their action, and the combination of their use.
- Currently, the anticancer drugs are either cytostatic or cytotoxic. Cytostatic drugs focus on the blocking of tumor cell proliferation, while the cytotoxic drugs focus on the destruction of the cells.




- Cytotoxic chemotherapy refers to agents whose mechanisms of action cause cell death or prevent cell growth, generally through inhibiting microtubule function, protein function, or DNA synthesis.
- Cytostatic drugs slow down or stop the growth of specific cells by inhibiting their cell division. Depending on their specific mechanism of action, cytostatic drugs interfere with cell division in different ways, for example by disturbing the metabolism or by damaging the DNA of a cell.
- There are over 50 such drugs, which can be used as single agents, or in combination, orally, IV and subcutaneously.








INTRODUCTION

In many countries, the caries process frequently progresses beyond the reversible stage and many people believe that loss of teeth is part of life. The main method of treating dental caries is extraction. The need to develop a new approach to oral care for use in economically less developed regions was reinforced by the World Health Organization (WHO). The ART was developed in Tanzania in mid-1980s as part of a community-based primary oral health program. The ART approach is based on minimal intervention and maximal prevention retaining sound tooth surface.






DISSCUSSION TOPIC: SAMPLING METHODS
